SUBJECT: Amending Title 11, Chapter 112, Section 112.12(A) of the Village Code

Class "I" Liquor License Clarification

Village Code Title 11, Chapter 112, Section 112.12(A) includes a Class "I" liquor license category which is currently available to "Not-for-Profit Clubs". There are currently three liquor licenses issued in the Class "I" category which are listed below:

- Lombard Park District d/b/a Western Acres Golf Course;
- Lombard Lodge 2350, Loyal Order of Moose d/b/a Lombard Moose Lodge; and
- Lifespace Communities, Inc. d/b/a Beacon Hill

The current definition of a "Not-for-profit club" as described in Section 112.01 does not properly describe the activities of all the Class "I" liquor licensees even though all the licensees are not-for-profit entities.

Consequently, Village staff met with Village Counsel who drafted the attached ordinance. This ordinance clarifies that the service of alcohol is for consumption on the licenses premises only (no package sales allowed), and now includes more specific language describing each of the entities that currently hold a Class "I" liquor license by including "not-for-profit entities" and "governmental entities" in addition to "not-for-profit clubs".

Please place this item on the December 6, 2018 Village Board agenda for consideration with a waiver of first reading.

## AN ORDINANCE AMENDING TITLE 11, CHAPTER 112, SECTION 112.12(A) OF THE LOMBARD VILLAGE CODE IN REGARD TO ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES AND THE CLASS "I" LIQUOR LICENSE CATEGORY

**BE IT ORDAINED** by the President and Board of Trustees of the Village of Lombard, DuPage County, Illinois, as follows:

SECTION 1: That Title 11, Chapter 112, Section 112.12(A) of the Lombard Village Code is amended by revising the language therein, relative to the Class "I" liquor license category, to read in its entirety as follows:

"Class "I" – Alcoholic beverages served for consumption on the premises of a not-for-profit club, not-for-profit entity or governmental entity; no package sales allowed."

**SECTION 2:** That this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage, approval and publication in pamphlet form, as provided by law.
