Honeyberry Café – 203 Yorktown, Suite 157B

The Village has received a request for a Class "A/B-I" liquor license from Yorktown Toastmaster Corporation d/b/a Honeyberry Café located at Yorktown Mall. Honeyberry Café will be located in the tenant space that Egg Harbor previously occupied. Their business model is also very similar in that they will offer breakfast and brunch selections as well as gluten-free and vegan options, salads, sandwiches and wraps. Honeyberry Café will operate seven days a week with limited hours. Their menu will also include six craft cocktails including but not limited to a Bloody Mary, Irish Coffee and Mimosas.

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING TITLE 11, CHAPTER 112, SECTION 112.13(A) OF THE LOMBARD VILLAGE CODE IN REGARD TO ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE PRESIDENT AND BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE VILLAGE OF LOMBARD, DU PAGE COUNTY, ILLINOIS as follows:

Section 1: That Title 11, Chapter 112, Section 112.13(A) of the Lombard Village Code is amended by revising the entry relative to the Class "A/B I" liquor license, contained therein, to read as follows:

Class "A/B-I" - 8

This increase in Class "A/B-I" liquor licenses reflects the issuance of a Class "A/B-I" liquor license to Yorktown Toastmaster Corporation who will be operating the business commonly known as Honeyberry Café located at 203 Yorktown (Yorktown Mall), Suite 157B, Lombard.

Section 2: This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and approval as required by law.
