

SUBJECT: PC 16-15; College Preparatory School of America (CPSA) – 331 W.

Madison Street - Letter of Credit Time Extension

In 2016, the Village Board approved zoning actions associated with the College Preparatory School of America (CPSA) expansion at 331 W. Madison Street. Since the approval date, the school has advanced constriction activities on their project, including undertaking stormwater detention improvements, a parking lot expansion and construction of the school building itself. By code, any defined public improvements to be constructed shall be required to post a Letter of Credit (LOC) to ensure that such improvements are constructed per code requirements. The LOC also provides assurances to the Village for any such improvements that are will ultimately be accepted and maintained by the Village were properly completed.

The original LOC was issued on April 20, 2107, with an expiration date of April 20, 2019. Section 154.603 (E) Extension of Letter of Credit reads as follows:

The Director of Community Development, upon written proof of difficulty, shall have the authority to grant one extension of the instrument of credit, not to exceed six months. The Village Board may, upon written proof of difficulty, grant additional extensions of the instrument of credit. Prior to any extension, an amendment to the Development Agreement shall be submitted which proposes a revised schedule of construction in compliance with the terms of this section.

Staff has received an updated construction schedule noting that the project will continue through the 2019 construction season and beyond the six-month period that would otherwise allow the Director of Community Development to extend the LOC as an administrative item. CPSA has provided staff with the attached correspondence (and supplemental documents for staff processing) extending the LOC for an additional twelve-month period, to April 20, 2020.
