ORDINANCE 7700

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING TITLE XV, CHAPTER 151, SECTIONS 151.03(A) AND (B)(2) OF THE LOMBARD VILLAGE CODE

Chapter 151: Flood Control (Stormwater and Floodplain Regulations)

WHEREAS, the Village of Lombard has established stormwater, floodplain and flood control regulations which are found in Title XV, Chapter 151 of the Lombard Village Code; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Trustees deem it reasonable to periodically review Title XV, Chapter 151 of the Lombard Village Code, and make necessary changes thereto;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE PRESIDENT AND BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE VILLAGE OF LOMBARD, DU PAGE COUNTY, ILLINOIS, as follows:

SECTION 1: Effective August 16, 2019, Title XV, Chapter 151, section 151.03(A) of the Lombard Village Code is hereby amended to read in its entirety as follows:

(A) Adoption of DuPage County Countywide Stormwater and Floodplain Ordinance, as a partial waiver community: It is hereby adopted by the Village for the purpose of establishing rules and regulations for the construction, alteration, use and occupancy, location and maintenance of land development and building construction in accordance with proper floodplain and stormwater controls, including permits and penalties, that certain code known as the DuPage County Countywide Stormwater and Floodplain Ordinance (hereinafter the "DuPage County Ordinance" in this Chapter), being particularly the May 14, 2019, edition thereof, and all subsequent amendments, and the whole thereof, save and except such portions as are hereinafter deleted, modified or amended per § 151.04 of this Code, of which one copy has been and now is filed in the office of the Village Clerk, and the same is hereby adopted and incorporated as fully as if set out at length therein, and from the date on which this section shall take effect, the provisions the DuPage County Ordinance shall be controlling within the village. All definitions as defined in Appendix A in the DuPage County Ordinance are hereby incorporated by reference into this Chapter. The designated Village Stormwater Administrator is the Private Development Engineer in the Community Development Department. The Director of Community Development referred to in this Chapter shall be the Director of Community Development and/or his/her designee.

SECTION 2: Effective August 16, 2019, Title XV, Chapter 151, section 151.03(B)(2) of the Lombard Village Code is hereby amended to read in its entirety as follows:

- (2) Flood insurance study, DuPage County, Illinois and incorporated areas, dated August 1, 2019, and all subsequent revisions, including the following specific stream flood profiles:
 - (a) East Branch of the DuPage River (EBEB) and tributaries;
 - (b) Glen Park Tributary (EBGP):
 - (c) Lacey Creek (EBLA);
 - (d) 22 nd Street (EBTS);
 - (e) Salt Creek (SCSC);
 - (f) Ginger Creek (SCGC);

Approved by me this 15th day of August, 2019.

- (g) Sugar Creek (SCSU); and
- (h) Westwood Creek (SCWC).

SECTION 3: That this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage, approval and publication in pamphlet form as provided by law.
