For many years there has been a stop sign placed on Taylor Avenue to the entrance to Madison Meadows Park that was placed within the intersection of the parking lot. With the construction of the Madison Meadows Recreation Center and reconfiguration of the parking lot, that stop sign is no longer needed. The attached pictures will show the description.

This matter was presented to the Public Safety and Transportation Committee on March 4th 2020. At the meeting, the committee voted 6-0 to approve the removal of the stop sign.

Ordinance No. 1186

WHEREAS, the President and Board of Trustees of the Village of Lombard have heretofore passed and approved Ordinance 1186, An Ordinance Regulating Traffic in the Village of Lombard (hereinafter the Lombard Traffic Code); and

WHEREAS, the President and Board of Trustees of the Village of Lombard find that the Lombard Traffic Code has been amended from time to time; and

WHEREAS, the Transportation and Safety Committee has reviewed the appropriate traffic studies and recommends certain changes to the Lombard Traffic Code; and

WHEREAS, the Corporate Authorities of the Village of Lombard concur in the recommendation of the Transportation and Safety Committee.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE PRESIDENT AND BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE VILLAGE OF LOMBARD, DU PAGE COUNTY, ILLINOIS, as follows:

Section 1: That Schedule IV (STOP STREETS) of the Lombard Traffic Code (Ordinance 1186) is amended to reflect the removal of the following:

"In accordance with Section 10-9-4 and when signs are erected giving notice thereof, drivers of vehicles proceeding on Taylor Road, Eastbound shall stop at the entrance to Park District property."
