Request for Class B Coin-Operated License

PacMan Zone, Yorktown

Staff has received a request from PacMan Zone for a Class B coin-operated license. PacMan Zone, which will be located within Yorktown Mall, will operate as a themed family entertainment center consisting of over 50 amusement devices. They will also have the ability to host special events for birthdays, anniversaries, graduations, etc.

Coin-operated devices are one of many types of business licenses. Village Code Title XI, Chapter 110, Section 110.21(C) states there shall be issued no more than the stated number of annual coin-operated licenses. These licenses are categorized into two Classes:

Class A-number of business establishments that have four to eight coin-operated devices on site. Class B-number of business establishments that have over eight coin-operated devices on site.

Currently there are two (2) licenses issued in the Class A category and two (2) licenses issued in the Class B category (The Game Room and Enchanted Castle). PacMan Zone is requesting a Class B license, consequently, the number of licenses in the Class B category will increase from two to three.

Attached is an ordinance increasing the allowable licenses under the Class B coin-operated license category from two (2) to three (3) to account for the aforementioned request.

PacMan Zone's anticipated opening date is early March and are requesting a waiver of first reading.

## AN ORDINANCE AMENDING TITLE XI, CHAPTER 110, SECTION 110.21(C) OF THE LOMBARD VILLAGE CODE IN REGARD TO THE NUMBER OF CLASS B COIN-OPERATED LICENSES

## BE IT ORDAINED BY THE PRESIDENT AND BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE VILLAGE OF LOMBARD, DU PAGE COUNTY, ILLINOIS, as follows:

<u>SECTION 1</u>: That Title XI, Chapter 110, Section 110.21(C) of the Lombard Village Code is hereby amended to read as follows:

(C) In addition to the license required by subsection (B) for each individual coinoperated amusement device, there shall be issued no more than the stated number of annual licenses in the following classifications for persons, firms, corporations or associations displaying for public patronage or keeping for operation any coin-operated amusement device:

Class A

Four to eight coin-operated amusement devices.

No more than two licenses.

Class B

More than eight coin-operated amusement devices.

No more than two three licenses.

SECTION 2: That this ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage, approval, and publication in pamphlet form as provided by law.
