The following is a recommendation from the Community Promotion & Tourism Committee for funding through the Local Tourism Grant Program for the Glenbard East Boosters in an amount not to exceed \$10,000 for the 2020 Ale Fest event, a summer food and craft beer fundraiser to be held on June 13, 2020.

Grant Request: \$10,000

The Glenbard East Boosters has requested a grant in the amount of \$10,000 to be used towards the administration of the 2020 Ale Fest Event. The event will be held on Parkside Avenue in downtown Lombard and will feature food trucks and a wide variety of craft beers for sampling. Proceeds of the event will primarily benefit the Glenbard East turf field fund. This is the 6th consecutive year this event will be held.
