EXECUTIVE ORDER NO. 2020-01

EXECUTIVE ORDER REGARDING PEDDLING AND SOLICITING UNDER A DECLARATION OF A STATE OF EMERGENCY IN THE VILLAGE OF LOMBARD, DUPAGE COUNTY, ILLINOIS

(COVID-19 - MARCH 20, 2020)

- WHEREAS, the Village of Lombard (the "Village") is a non-home rule unit of local government, as provided by Article VII, Section 7 of the Illinois Constitution of 1970; and
- WHEREAS, COVID-19 is a dangerous disease which has spread around the world, including in the United States, the State of Illinois and DuPage County; and
- **WHEREAS**, COVID-19 is a direct and serious threat to the public's health, safety and welfare; and
- WHEREAS, on March 20, 2020, the Village President declared a state of emergency in the Village in Declaration 2020-1, entitled "Declaration of a State of Emergency in the Village of Lombard, DuPage County, Illinois (COVID-19 March 20, 2020)" (the "Declaration"); and
- WHEREAS, the Declaration was made pursuant to authority granted to the Village President in Section 31.18 of the Lombard Village Code, entitled "Village President's Authority to Declare a State of Emergency," and pursuant to Section 11-1-6 of the Illinois Municipal Code (65 ILCS 5/11-1-6); and
- **WHEREAS**, the Village President has determined that it is necessary to make this Executive Order to best protect the public's health, safety and welfare regarding COVID-19;
- **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDERED,** by the Village President of the Village of Lombard, DuPage County, Illinois, as follows:
- **SECTION 1**: **Incorporation.** That the recitals above shall be and are incorporated in this Section 1 as if restated herein.

SECTION 2: Executive Order. That it is ordered as follows:

1. It shall hereby be unlawful for any person to engage in peddling, commercial soliciting or fund soliciting, as defined in Chapter 118 of the Lombard Village Code, in the Village of Lombard for so long as this Executive Order is in effect. Any licenses for peddling or soliciting previously issued under Chapter 118 of the Lombard Village Code are hereby declared void for so long as this Executive Order is in effect. The Village Clerk shall not accept any new applications for peddling and soliciting and no new

licenses for peddling and soliciting shall be issued by the Village of Lombard for so long as this Executive Order is in effect.

SECTION 3: Duration. That this Executive Order shall expire upon the earlier of: (a) the Declaration ending; or (b) withdrawal of this Executive Order by the Village President.
